ORIENTATION DAY FOR YEAR 7 STUDENTS - 2022

On behalf of all the staff and students at Prairiewood High School, we wish to take this opportunity to welcome you and your child to Prairiewood High School. The school community wishes to extend its welcome by inviting your child to attend Year 6 Orientation Day to be held at Prairiewood High School on Friday 10th of December 2021 from 10:00am - 12:15pm.

This orientation day is designed to assist Year 6 students in a smoother shift between Primary School and High School. Students will be welcomed to Prairiewood High School, given a tour of our school and participate in some activities with our 2022 Year 12 Prefect Body. The day is designed to give students an idea of subjects, opportunities, and support at Prairiewood High School.

****Your child will come home with a folder containing some very IMPORTANT INFORMATION. Some components are just for your reading and future reference whereas key documents will need to be signed and returned to the school.**

Please note the below information relating to the day:

- You will need to arrange transport to and from school. Students are not able to arrive on site until after 9:30am for a 10am start. Due to COVID-19 restrictions we are unable to have parents on site for this visit. Parents may drop off students at either the Stocklands Gate (Entrance 9) or Main Gate (Entrance 4). Staff will be present to greet you and your child. Parents with questions or materials to drop off should come to the Stocklands Gate and ask for our Business Manager.

Those who have a sibling at the school may remain on-site for collection at 1pm.

- Students are required to wear their own primary school uniform.
- Students will be provided with morning tea. This will include a sandwich and a piece of fruit. Students may purchase a drink or additional snack at the canteen and are encouraged to bring their own water bottle to refill at the water stations around school.
- If your child has an epi-pen or asthma puffer, or any other medication, they are to bring this along with them for the day. This should be accompanied by a note outlining the dosage, timing and any other important details. This must be given to a member of staff on arrival.
- **Uniform collection:** If an order for your child's uniform is placed prior to Tuesday 7th December, it will be delivered to your child at the end of Orientation Day.
Uniform collection following Orientation Day will be available on Tuesday 14th December from 1pm-3pm or by appointment from the school office.

Again, welcome, and we look forward to meeting and working with you and your child in 2022 and beyond.
