

Course: TRAVEL AND TOURISM



2 Units for each of Preliminary and HSC

Course Description:

This course is designed for all students who have a general interest in languages and travel with very little emphasis on grammar. The course will enable students to be better prepared for overseas travel and communicate at a basic level in tourist-oriented situations.

Preliminary Course

Students will begin to develop their knowledge and understanding of travel preparations and procedures.

HSC Course

Students will acquire some knowledge of basic French and Italian that would be required by a tourist travelling in countries that speak these languages.

Main Topics Covered:

- Official Travel Documentation
- Budgeting
- Travel Services
- Currency/Foreign Exchange
- Itineraries
- French and Italian local customs
- Everyday French and Italian – eating out, accommodation, bus and train travel, numbers, shops, shopping, directions etc.
