**Tell Them From Me student survey:
Information and consent form for
parents and carers**



Dear Parents and Carers,

Back in Term 2 2022, our school took part in the Snapshot #1 'Tell Them From Me' student survey. We are now getting all students to do Snapshot #2.

The survey will provide us with valuable feedback on what our students think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. The survey is completed online and is run by an independent research company, **The Learning Bar**, which specialises in school-based surveys.

Staff in schools will **not** be able to identify individual students from their responses. The survey typically takes 30 minutes or less to complete. Once the surveys are completed by students, reports are prepared and in most cases are available to schools within three business days.

As well as schools getting student feedback, the Department of Education is running a research project to look at state-wide patterns of student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices. The research is looking at how these things impact on student outcomes, including academic performance. Individual students will **not** be identified in any CESE publications, and all information will be handled in accordance with the relevant privacy legislation. Students' personal information will not be disclosed by the department to any other person or body other than as required by law.

Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary. Your child will not take part if either you or your child do not wish. If, during the survey, your child is uncomfortable, he/she can choose to stop the survey at any time. The majority of questions in the survey can be skipped.

The survey will take place online - in class - before 4 November.

If you **do not want your child to take part** in the survey, please complete the form on the back of this sheet and have your child return it to the **school office** by **Thursday, 20 October 2022**.
